

OSWEGO RV REGULATIONS

1. Quiet time will be from 10 p.m. until 8 a.m. each day. Please do not leave your generators running during this time.
2. Pets must be kept on a leash and the owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets and properly disposing of the waste.
3. Camp Fires may be in designated areas only. Camp fires must be extinguished by the person(s) starting the fire prior to leaving the campsite.
4. The official time for payment begins at 3:00 p.m. each day.
5. No washing cars, trucks, trailers, or motor homes, or changing your oil at the campground.
6. A dump station is available at Kamp Siesta, southeast of the bathrooms.
7. No trash shall be left at the campsites. Place all trash inside the dumpster.
8. Bathrooms are cleaned daily Monday thru Friday.
9. For reservations call the Oswego City Office at 620-795-4433 Monday thru Friday, 8am to 5 pm.
10. No showers or bulk water to be used by anyone other than campers. Bulk water is limited to filling RV water storage only.
11. Rates are as follows:
 - a. \$15.00 per day whether spots are reserved or on a first come first serve basis.
 - b. Tents--\$10.00 if they are using water and electricity, and the bathhouse.
 - c. Special tent rate of \$5.00 for Scouts etc. only with an OK by City Clerk.
 - d. *Monthly Rate* - \$300.00 with prior approval and can stay up to 1 year except for Fair Week. Must **PAY IN ADVANCE** *each month* at the City Office. Can add additional weeks at the rate of \$75.00 per week but must stay a full month initially. (NO weekly rate)
 - e. *Special Rates*—Construction Crews will be provided a special rate per month, for up to 1 year except for Fair Week, if they are working on a job in the immediate area.
12. Payments may be made at:
 - (1) Kamp Siesta. Envelopes are available at the Restroom/Shower House. Please fill out information on front of envelope, enclose check or cash in the envelope and drop in the night deposit box located at the Restroom/Shower House. **Monthly rates must be pre-paid at City Office.**
 - (2) Oswego Police Department located at 703 5th Street.
 - (3) City Office, 703 5th Street 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday thru Friday, closed all major holidays. Drop box at this site is to the east of the front door.

Directions: From 6th St or Hwy 160, go north on either Kansas or Wisconsin to North St, which runs in front of Labette County Fairgrounds. On Kansas you will turn left and then back to the right at the first road going north. On Wisconsin turn left and go one block then back to the right at the first road going north. Do not go straight past the gates at the top of the hill with a camper or motor home, as you could incur damage to your rig.
