Easement – Oswego Correctional Facility

Peine advised the correctional facility had requested an easement to install a fiber cable between the two buildings. The easement would run from the north facility, under Seventh Street (they will bore under the road) and will run on the east side of Fordyce Street to the south facility property. The easement is for crossing Seventh Street and within the right of way of Fordyce Street.

Brown made a motion and Lewis seconded to approve an easement to the Kansas Department of Corrections for the Oswego Correctional Facility as submitted. Motion carried.

Swimming Pool – Core Samples in Pool Floor & Walls

Peine submitted quotes from two companies to take core samples from the swimming pool floor and walls. The quotes were from:

Council inquired what the size of the samples to be taken would be; and what type of testing would be done, such as compressions, etc. Supt. Allison will contact Jeff Bartley, Water's Aquatic Edge and visit with him and present more information at the October 10 regular meeting.
